5. Review and approve quarterly investment report for second quarter;
6. Receive monthly report from Chief Smith with SMHCEMS regarding emergency operation, response times, call volume, training, management activities, and membership;

9. Discuss and consider action on annexation of territory not included in the District, including:

 - Ordering a hearing on the Petition and authorizing publication of notice of the hearing;
10. Discuss and consider action on possible Uhland Fire and EMS Station with presentation from Uhland representative;
11. Discussion and possible action on proposed meeting with HCESD No. 5 and Kinder Morgan regarding the natural gas pipeline in HCESD No. 5 and 9 district boundaries;
12. Discuss time, place, date, and agenda items for next meeting; and
13. Adjourn.
